8.2 Affixing Labels to Folders and Boxes

Labels for custom boxes should be placed in the upper left hand corner of the front face of the box. Place them in the same order as on a folder, top to bottom, rather than left to right.

Place routing labels (or document pouches) on the top surface of boxes or the side of pallets, making sure the bar code is fully flat and visible, not bent over the edge.

You must affix the label to the side of the box if the dimensions of the box allow. However, if the box size does not allow the entire label to be affixed to the side of the box, you may place it on the top of the box.

Individually packaged products supplied to the B2B channel in secondary ...

It is always preferable to affix the label to each primary packaging. When this is not possible, the labeling can be placed on the sales unit, then on the multipack / secondary packaging

Avoid Shipping Delays: The Best Way to Attach
