

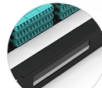

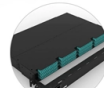

Based in Addis Ababa, it is one of the "Big-5" group of state owned corporations in Ethiopia, along with Ethiopian Airlines, the Commercial Bank of Ethiopia, Ethiopian Insurance Corporation, and the Ethiopian Shipping Lines. Ethio Telecom (stylised as ethio telecom; Amharic: ኢትዮ ግብይት), previously known as the Ethiopian Telecommunications Corporation (Amharic: ኢትዮጵያ ግብይት ኮርፖሬሽን ፎካል ፎንድስ, ETC), is an Ethiopian telecommunication company serving as the major internet, telephone and digital services provider. Ethiopia's telecom monopoly ended in 2021, when ECA awarded Safaricom Ethiopia the country's first private sector operator license.
